


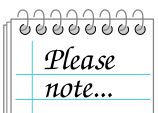

How would you like to be a slave, to be told what to do every moment, to be unable to choose anything for yourself? How would you like to be in prison, your life controlled by the guards? How would you like to be in a country where the government oppressed you and imposed many restrictions on your life? We take our freedom for granted in Australia but many people in the world don't enjoy the freedoms we enjoy. Galatians talks about the freedom we enjoy in Christ. It is the freedom from restrictions and controls the Jewish law imposed on people.

When Paul talks about the law he is not just thinking of the Ten Commandments. The 'Law' could refer to the first five books of the Old Testament. But Paul is referring to all the rules and regulations added to the Old Testament that regulated food, purity, Sabbath and so much of life.

We are not free just to please ourselves but to serve God in love. This will require the same dedication that the Jews had but not expressed by their legalism. It does not mean just being slack. It will include helpful personal disciplines.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Following a meeting of our young families group with Bishop Stuart a decision has been made to seek a funding grant to employ a Young Families Ministry Pastor. This position would be for two days a week to work with young families particularly through PlayTime. We have contact with about 50 families at the moment and PlayTime has grown to two mornings a week now. There is a big need for someone with time to help with this ministry so we can effectively reach out to this group and build on the relationships that have developed. We want to move towards some form of worship experience for families with small children, sometimes called 'Messy Church'. We have begun a 'Mini Kid's Church' on Sunday mornings for little ones alongside our GTs for school age children. The grant is being sought through the Pelican Foundation, an arm of the Diocese.

As well as this the wardens are planning additional storage to increase the amount of space for both the PlayTime and Kid's Church on Sundays. This storage will probably be located in the grass area behind the store room at the back of the church.

All this is very exciting but we need to surround these decisions with prayer; firstly that the grant will be approved, and then above all that God would raise up the right person for this ministry. We also need to prayerfully review our giving. If this ministry is to be sustained beyond the life of the grant we need to raise extra financial support. I believe God has opened the door to a significant ministry here and a vital one for the future ministry of the gospel in our community.
