


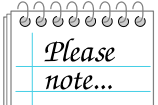

**I**f you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. (Galatians 3:29) *We can easily concentrate on the New Testament and forget the foundation laid in the Old Testament. Paul's point in this passage is that through faith in Jesus we become children of Abraham (not just God's children). God gave his promise initially to Abraham and we inherit the promises through our relationship to him. We tend to think very individualistically but God's plan is to draw us into a family, a family that stretches back to Abraham.*

*Through Jesus we have a new relationship with God as Father. This is an intimate relationship where the Spirit leads us to shout to God, with the intimacy of a small child, to his or her father as "Abba". No longer do we have a relationship of keeping rules with the fear of failure.*

*Through Jesus we are brought into God's family. We have a new relationship with all who put their trust in him. All barriers of race, colour, gender, class, caste or status (slave or free) are gone. This new bond with each other is central in God's plan.*

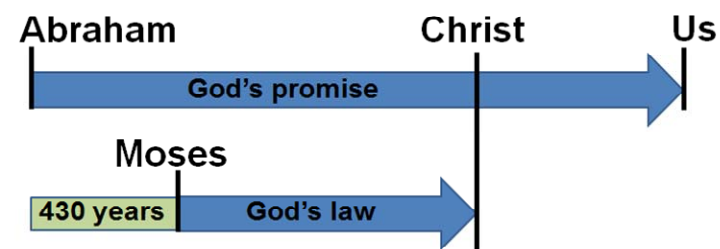
